2026 Ad Valorem Property Tax Levy Rate Resolution #26-10

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.030, the Tightwad Fire Protection District has approved a budget for the upcoming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(1) the District's Budget Officer presented to the District's Board of Directors, the following information for each tax rate to be levied:

- The assessed valuation by category of property for the fiscal year for which the tax is to be levied;
- The assessed valuation by category of property for the preceding taxable year;
- The amount of revenue required to be provided from the property tax as set forth in the annual budget adopted;
- The amount of sales taxes collected during the preceding year; and
- The tax rate proposed to be set as adjusted by half the amount of sales taxes collected during the preceding year; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(2) the District published on August 13, 2026, a proper notice stating the hour, date, and place of a public hearing on the proposed rates of taxes in *The Clinton Daily Democrat*; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(2) the District posted a proper notice stating the hour, date, and place of a public hearing on the proposed rates of taxes at the following public places:

- Tightwad Fire Station, 11585 East Highway 7, Tightwad, Missouri;
- Souls Harbor Worship Center, 1151 East Highway 7, Tightwad, Missouri;
- Coal Fire Station, 777 Southeast 250 Rd, Clinton, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(2) the District held at least one public hearing on the proposed rates of taxes at which citizens were heard prior to their approval; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 321.552(3) the governing body of the ... fire protection district shall lower the level of its tax rate by an amount which reduces property tax revenues by an amount equal to fifty percent of the amount of sales tax collected in the preceding year; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(2) the District's proposed rates of taxes are calculated to produce substantially the same revenues as required in the annual budget adopted; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 67.110(1) the District must fix its ad valorem property tax rates not later than September first for entry in the tax books.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The total 2026 ad valorem property tax rate for the District is fixed at \$0.1783; and
2. That the District's Secretary shall have a copy of this Resolution submitted to the Henry County Clerk by 5pm on August 31, 2026, in coordination with the District's Budget Officer; and
3. That the District's Budget Officer shall have the Pro Forma Summary Page with the certification of property tax levy rate submitted to the Henry County Clerk's office by 5pm on August 31, 2026, in coordination with the District's Budget Officer and District's Secretary.
